Prepare for the Challenge

The competition deliverable is a digital poster board. Laptops will be required to properly participate. You may also bring a computer mouse, tablet, design calculators, scales, and any other tools/accessories that may be helpful.

Collaborate with Your Team

The Bridge the Gap team will assign you to a discipline and a team of 6-7 people. Teams will have at least one representative for each discipline, and an effort will be made to mix students from different schools. Students should expect to receive their first or second choice of discipline in most cases.

Develop an Integrated Design

Work with your team to design an AE project. The project description will be announced shortly before the design time starts. Past project assignments have included a boutique hotel and a small community center. Teams are typically allotted between 120 and 180 minutes to complete their digital posters.

Celebrate the Industry

Learn about the various disciplines that make up the architectural engineering industry and experience how their integration can bring ideas to life. Network with other students, professionals, and academics and celebrate what makes our industry special.
