- We launched the Military Engineer Leadership Fund to support early-career military engineers and expanded our impact through the Younger Member Global Activities Fund.
- We supported more than 10,000 students through 22 Student Symposia, culminating in the high-energy Civil Engineering Student Championships at Cal Poly San Luis Obispo.
- We provided educators and students with the mentorship tools essential for long-term growth through the ExCEED Teaching Workshops and the expanded Briaud Students Fund.

As participation in these programs grows, so does the impact of your generosity. This report is an opportunity to reflect on the progress we have made together—but as any engineer knows, reflection is only useful if it informs what we build next.

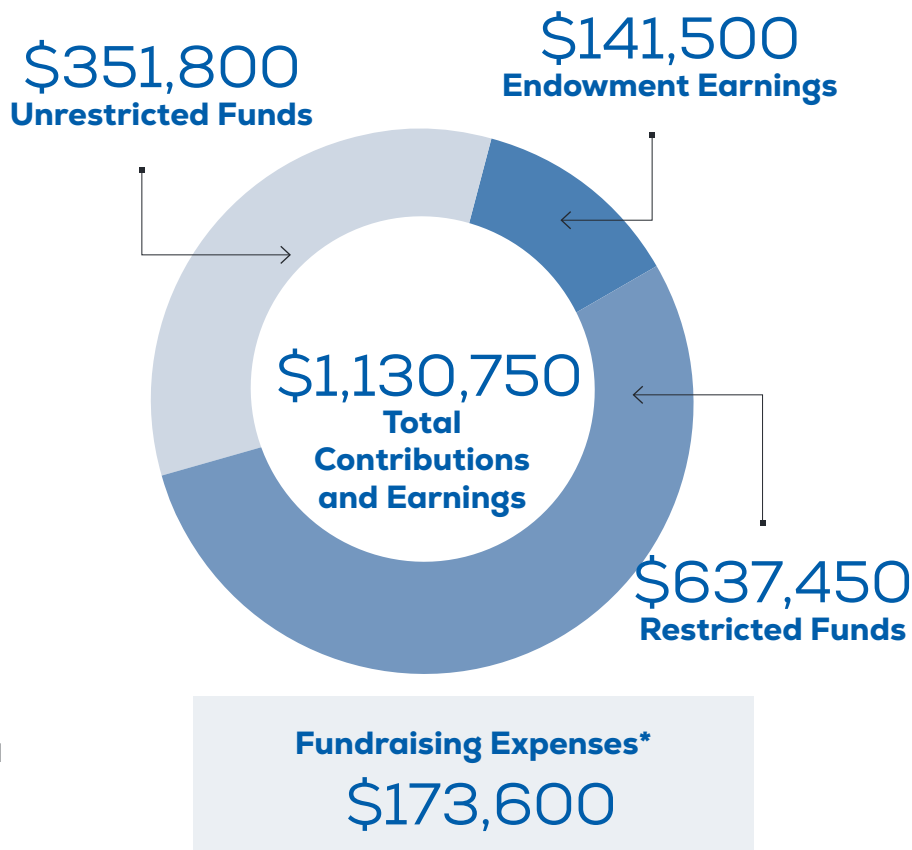
FUNDRAISING REPORT

The ASCE Foundation manages a diverse portfolio of funds designed to **transform philanthropic intent into professional impact**. These funds include both restricted and unrestricted accounts. Because ASCE covers the Foundation's operating expenses, **100% of every dollar** donated is invested directly back into ASCE programs. These contributions bolster ASCE's mission-driven programs and accelerate the Society's impact.

Fundraising expenses include costs incurred to specifically cultivate and solicit financial contributions to the Foundation—such as such as donation software and donor database, production and mailing for donor communications and solicitations, and overall donor development.

STUDENT PROGRAMS

Building Confidence, Capability, and Community

As the entry point into the profession, engineering students develop the skills and connections that will serve them throughout their careers. Through ASCE's student programs, members strengthen technical expertise while developing leadership and project management skills and gaining access to a global network of mentors and employers.

Civil Engineering Student Championships

The 2025 ASCE Student Championships were held at Cal Poly San Luis Obispo and featured the National Concrete Canoe Competition, Sustainable Solutions Competition, and UESI Surveying Competition, along with an exhibition of the emerging Timber-Strong Design Build Competition.

A total of 470 students competed across 18 Concrete Canoe teams, 22 Sustainable Solutions teams, and 19 Surveying teams, showcasing proficiency in project management, planning, teamwork, leadership, and communication to complement their finely honed engineering skills throughout the competitions. We also welcomed teams from Canada, China, and India.

Briaud Students Fund

In 2025, the Briaud Students Fund expanded to support students interested in Geo-Institute programs. In addition to helping nine students attend the 2025 ASCE Convention, the fund supported two students attending Geotechnical Frontiers 2025 event.

The Briaud Students Fund also provided a travel stipend for Student Chapters attending the Workshops for Student Chapter Leaders during the Multi-Region Leadership Symposia. Since the stipends were introduced, student chapter participation has increased by 15%, creating more opportunities for networking, leadership development, and the exchange of best practices among students and ASCE volunteer leaders.

Student Symposia

During the spring, ASCE hosted 22 Student Symposia worldwide, bringing together more than 10,000 students for regional competitions and leadership and professional development opportunities.

LEADERSHIP PROGRAMS

Preparing Engineers to Lead with Purpose

ASCE members sharpen their management skills through volunteer experience and specialized training. These programs aid in delivering infrastructure projects effectively and advancing careers to the executive level.

Multi-Region Leadership Conferences (MRLCs)

The Multi-Region Leadership Conferences bring together society leaders, younger members, and students for a dynamic two-day conference. Over the two days in Cleveland, Memphis, and San Diego, upcoming leaders gained knowledge of the Society and its resources, networked with peers in their Regions, and strengthened their leadership skills to set them up for success in their positions.

During the events, the Foundation **awarded three \$500 grants** to support student chapters, younger member groups, branches, and sections.

Younger Member Leadership Symposium

The Committee on Younger Members hosted the Younger Member Leadership Symposium (YMLS) in August. Forty-five younger members gathered at ASCE Headquarters in Reston, Virginia, for development training, technical tours, and peer-to-peer networking.

The Alumni Summit provided YMLS alumni with the opportunity to network and engage with advanced leadership and project management training.

Centennial Anniversary Grant

In 2025, the Arizona Section celebrated its centennial anniversary. The Foundation supported their celebrations through our Centennial Anniversary grant. The Foundation was proud to help support the development of their Centennial Celebration video and gala event.



Military Engineer Leadership Fund

Founded by Lt. Col. Robert Wolff, Ph.D., USA (Ret.), F.ASCE, F.SAME, the Military Engineer Leadership Fund supports early-career military engineers attending the Younger Member Leadership Symposium—helping them build the leadership skills and professional networks that connect military and civilian engineering practice.

ENGINEERING PROGRAMS

Advancing Knowledge, Informing Decisions

From driving informed infrastructure decisions to developing ASCE members' technical knowledge, our Engineering programs support ASCE members in advancing the profession. ASCE Engineering programs give ASCE members the knowledge and skills needed to address the wide variety of infrastructure challenges across the sector. The Report Card received record coverage with more than 17,000 references across print, broadcast, and online media.



2025 Report Card for America's Infrastructure

In March, ASCE released the *2025 Report Card for America's Infrastructure*. For the first time, America's infrastructure received an overall C rating after improvements in 8 categories following government and private sector investments and prioritization.

Alongside the Report Card launch, ASCE hosted a Solutions Summit in Washington that drew industry leaders, members of Congress, and ASCE members. The summit hosted more than 200 in-person attendees, who participated in sessions that spanned the infrastructure sector. More than 2,400 people either streamed or viewed recordings of the sessions.



Future World Vision & Cities of the Future

The Future World Vision program and the *Cities of the Future* IMAX film introduced students and engineers of all ages to the possibilities of the next half-century of infrastructure innovation, opportunities, and challenges. With technological change only accelerating, civil engineers will use the tools learned through these programs to drive the course of innovation and the profession forward into the future.

Sustainability and Infrastructure

The Foundation supports sustainability programs that produce technical resources, publications, and conferences that serve to spread best sustainable and resilient practices throughout the profession.

Institute Initiatives

The Foundation works with ASCE's Institutes to support their student competitions and specialized engineering programs, which help students gain specialized knowledge and hands-on industry experience.



Structural Engineering Institute [SEI]

Geo-Institute [G-I]



The Foundation, in collaboration with the Geo-Institute, supported student participation in Geo-Institute events through a portion of the Briaud Students Fund and the G-I Student Activities Fund.



Construction Institute [CI]



CI Student Days challenged students to respond to a request for proposals on the 143rd Street East Extension in Chicago as if they ran their own general contracting company. The student teams then presented their bids to a panel of industry leaders. Tufts University's "Shear Madness" team took first place in 2025 thanks to their collaborative approach.



Architectural Engineering Institute [AEI]



The AEI Student Design Competition challenged multidisciplinary teams of students to address real-world design and construction challenges. The three finalist teams, Lawrence Technological University, University of Nebraska-Lincoln, and California Polytechnic University San Luis Obispo, presented their proposals during the AEI Conference 2025.

EDUCATION PROGRAMS

Multiplying Impact Through Learning

ASCE Education programs give ASCE members the tools and opportunities to be effective ambassadors in introducing Civil Engineering to the next generation. This investment in the future of the profession and its practitioners will provide the profession with a strong workforce to meet future infrastructure needs.

Send a Kid to the Future

The Foundation continued to support the *Send a Kid to the Future* initiative to help high school students from across the country to see the *Cities of the Future* IMAX film.

ExCEED

Throughout the year, the ExCEED Teaching Workshops provided transformational professional development for 40 civil engineering educators from across the country. These educators honed their active learning, structured communication, and student-focused education skills through rigorous exercises, model classes, feedback sessions, and mentorship throughout the program.

In addition, a two-day mini-workshop was held in April focused on the unique needs of 30 early-career faculty members. During the mini-workshop, participants cemented their core teaching competencies that will benefit their students throughout their careers.

Convention

The 2025 ASCE Convention in Seattle drew engineers from around the world to discuss civil engineering innovation. The Foundation extended support to 19 students and younger members to attend the event through the Briaud Students and the Younger Member Global Funds. Through their attendance, they enriched the event with their enthusiasm, curiosity, and professionalism.

The Foundation also hosted a donor luncheon, which connected donors and society leaders with these young engineers while raising more than \$20,000 in funds for many of the key ASCE programs discussed in this report.

Pre-College Outreach

With the support of the ASCE Foundation, ASCE provides resources from games and activities to outreach material, such as *Dream Big* and *Cities of the Future*, to members to introduce the next generation to the civil engineering profession.
